Royal Caribbean makes European expansion

Europe is a great continent to cruise and Royal Caribbean knows it. The cruising giant has been expanding its activities in the region year after year and recently announced a record 12 of its 22 ships will be cruising the continent for the 2012 summer season.

The 2,500-passenger *Serenade of the Seas* will make her European debut, sailing out of Barcelona on a series of two different 12-night Mediterranean itineraries, one of which includes an overnight stay in Venice, the other including ports in Greece and Turkey.

Amsterdam will be the cruise line's new homeport in the region, with the 2,500-passenger *Brilliance of the Seas* sailing a number of new European itineraries out of the city and Copenhagen.

Other options include new Holy Land sailings, maiden ports and new "interports" where passengers can board in the midst of scheduled itineraries.
